



CLUB INFRASTRUCTURE ENHANCEMENTS AND UPGRADES - 2025

Every Committee aims to future-proof the Club by making enhancements and upgrades to facilities to benefit current and future members.

Recent examples include the very successful Director's Station, as well as upgrades to the latest technology with new laptops, new and improved audio / visual equipment and the complete replacement of the roof and guttering.

The Committee is now working on our next infrastructure improvement.

The area in front of the kitchen will be revamped. The tired and stained carpet around the Club entrance and the food serving area will be replaced with vinyl, creating a modern, fresh and contemporary look. This will be easy to maintain and keep clean and will be more practical when serving food.

In addition, a small, brand-new, purpose-built bar will be installed in the corner by the door transforming the current makeshift setup into a stylish and functional feature, which will raise the Club to a new level for Congresses and major Events.

The new bar will include custom-designed drawers to safely store glassware, and a secure, lockable bar fridge to keep beer and wine chilled and ready for use.

Under alcohol licencing regulations, the Club must ensure the responsible service of alcohol. Recent audits conducted after Congress events revealed that when drinks were served (rather than self-poured), players consumed lower amounts of alcohol.

This approach not only supports responsible drinking but also results in cost savings for the Club, without compromising on hospitality.

Thanks to the tireless work of our Club Grant expert, Greg Dobson, the Club is in receipt of a large grant which will assist in covering 50% of the total cost of this Club upgrade.

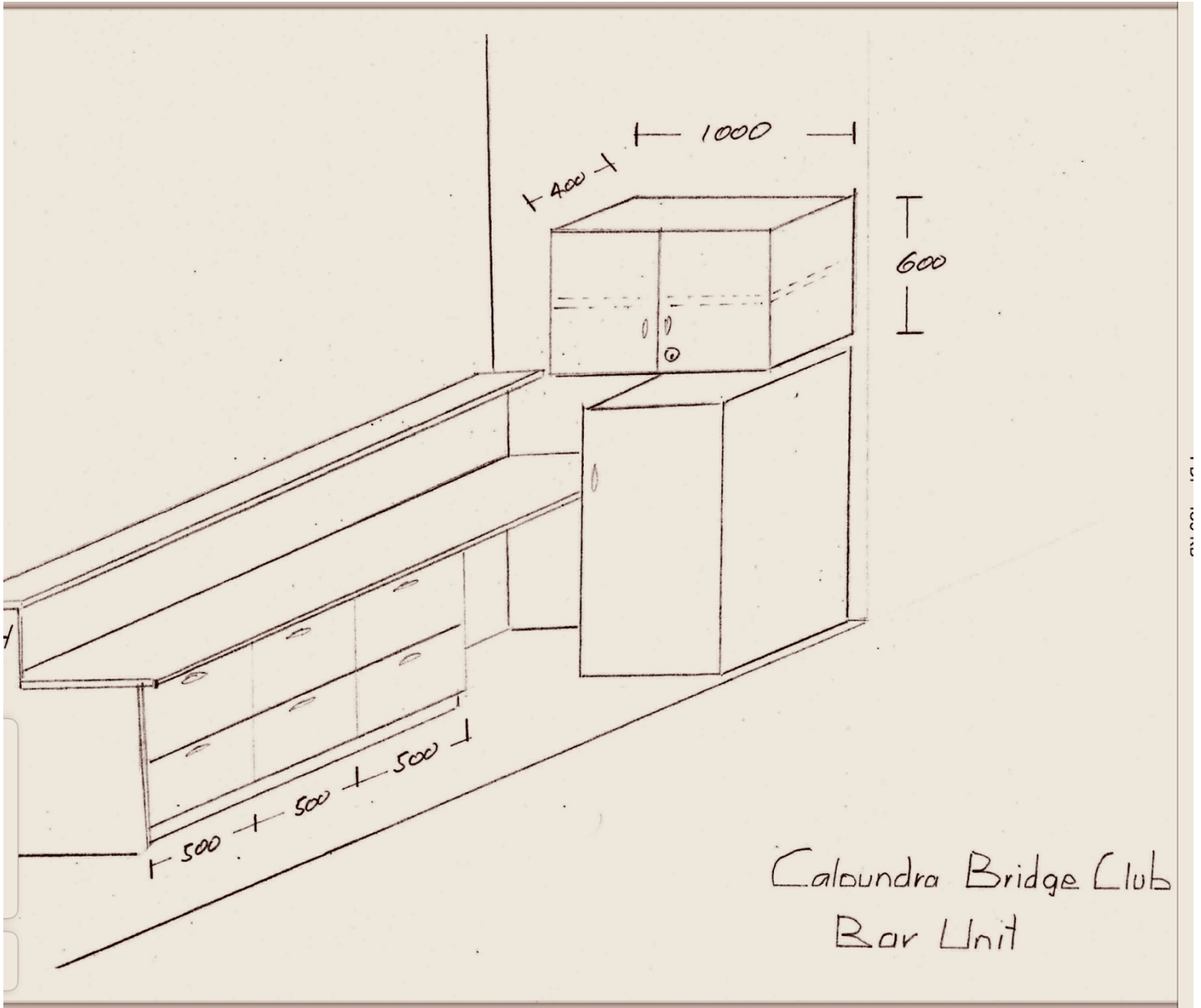
The total cost of this enhancement is \$14,515 with the Club receiving \$7,175 from the grant from the Sunshine Coast Council. Even after this expenditure the Club's financial position remains extremely strong.

This is a thrilling upgrade that sets a new benchmark for the Club, enhancing members' and visitors' experience alike and shaping the future of the Club facilities.
